

# "WATER POWERED JETPACK" FUN FACTS



THESE ARE THE FIRST JETPACKS IN THE SOUTHERN HEMISPHERE.

- IMPORTED FROM GERMANY (Invented by Ray Li, USA)
- Costing over \$150,000 Aud (landed) each.

## Statistics

- Reaches approx 10 metres high (30 feet) (3 Storey building)
- Water is pumped from a JetSki like device up a large hose to the Jetpack unit.
- Up to 4000 litres of water a minute can pump through the jetpack. That will empty a household pool in 10 minutes.
- Powered by a petrol 4 stroke motor / 250 horsepower or 190kw.
- It can carry a person up to 150 kilos.
- They are made of Carbon fibre and the jetpack has an inbuilt throttle on the Handle like a motorbike.
- The Jetpack has a 5 point safety harness similar to a racing car.
- The Jetpack can hover, go backwards and turn on a dime, up high or down low.
- Pilots can and will perform hands free at times, as the jetpacks are so stable.

## Safety

- The jetpack has a safety lanyard stop/start like a Jetski.
- You can place your hands in the water jets without being hurt.
- You could cruise up to 25 kilometres an hour for up to 2 hours.
- Most beginners can learn to fly in under 10 minutes from \$249 weekdays.
- Qld (Gold Coast) and Sydney (Penrith Regatta Centre) Jetpack training academies are now open.
